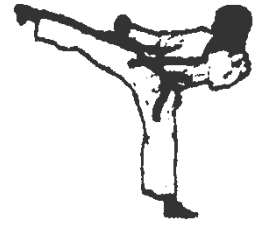

Order of Tournament Events

(Participants are grouped into the following events by age and belt rank)

1. **Escapes:** Participants may demonstrate an escape technique for any attack of their choosing.
2. **Best Kick:** Any three kicks of the participant's choosing; judged on form, speed, and power.
3. **Kata:** Performance of Young Americans Kata requirements at participant's current belt level.
4. **Light Contact Sparring:** Point sparring with light contact only between the chin and belt.
